Kids' Zone Our kids zone is home to inflatables, games, arts and crafts and more. On Saturday morning from 10:00 am - 11:00 a.m. we host a kids ride for ages 7 and under. The ride will circle around the soccer field at Myers Park Traditional and will end with an ice cream party. Bring your kids and their bikes to let them join the fun! Children on the Booty Loop Children ages 8-11 are permitted on the Booty Loop beginning at 12 p.m. on Saturday, July 30th! Packet pickup will begin at 11:45 a.m. in our expo area. Come out and join the ride! Food Let's be honest - food is a priority for anyone spending that much time on the bike! You'll be treated at the event to three square meals, a midnight pizza party and all the snacks and drinks you can handle! Vegetarian and gluten free options will be available.
